

The atmosphere of healing

When healing people, Jesus often said “The Kingdom of God has come upon you”, or “is near you”.

“Heal the sick there, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’” Luke 10:9

“If I cast out demons with the finger of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.” Luke 11:20

What is the Kingdom of God ? A realm over which a King exercises rule & authority.

*“The Kingdom of God (His reign) is not meat or drink but **righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.**” Rom. 14:17*

Where is the Kingdom of God?

- ❖ On the inside of you - *“(…) For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you.” Luke 17:21*
- ❖ In the Spirit - *“Do you not know that you are the temple of God, that the Spirit of God dwells in you?” 1 Cor. 3:16*

The Kingdom of God is not so much what we do on outside, rather what is happening on inside of us

“Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.” Prov. 4:23

RIGHTEOUSNESS – Assurance for your healing

→ Innocent, right before God without guilt, shame, complex of inferiority as if sin never existed.

*“Those who receive abundance of grace & of **the gift of righteousness** will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.” Rom. 5:17*

*“He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that **we might become** the righteousness of God in Him.” 2 Cor. 5:21*

Righteousness is God’s justice fulfilled in Jesus, to free us, and make us bold before Him and satan.

*“And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. Love has been perfected among us in this: that **we may have boldness in the day of judgment;** because as He is, so are we in this world.” 1 John 4:16-17*

Judgment – KRISIS – accusation, condemnation

1 John 4:16,17 says that when knowing our righteousness, and God’s love for us will keep us safe and bold when the devil comes with a voice of accusation and condemnation.

Eph 3:14-20 BE MORE AWARE OF GOD’S RIGHTEOUSNESS, LOVE & SPIRIT IN US, THAN DARKNESS.

A paralytic could not receive healing because of guilt/condemnation

→ *"When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, 'Son, your sins are forgiven you.' "*
1 John 4:16-17

1 John 3:21,22 no condemnation, shame, inferiority, have assurance to receive, boldness before satan.
Isaiah 54:14 "In righteousness you shall be established; You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear..."

Horizontal Righteousness

Mark 11:25 - James 5:14-16

"For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work." James 3:16

Seeking God's rule & righteousness will bring you into great peace

"Seek first Kingdom of God and His righteousness and everything shall be added unto you." Matt. 6:33

PEACE... Let yourself be guided by Holy Spirit

"For you shall go out with joy, And be led out with peace;" Isa. 55:12

"And let the peace of God rule in your hearts" Col. 3:15

1 Cor. 15:57 & 2 Cor. 2:14

Peace will guide you to your healing, seek it & protect it - Peace ≠ fear

"Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." John 14:27

→ Why? Because Fear can stop Holy Spirit's work, so what to do?

'When Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying, 'Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.' " Luke 8:50

When in doubt... always worship.

Meditate on God's faithfulness.

Matt. 6:25-34 Do not worry 4 times.

Heb. 11:11 - Phil. 4:6-7

Praying in the spirit will help receive a greater revelation

"God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, of love and of a sound mind." 2 Tim. 1:6-7

Sound mind – wisdom from Holy Spirit 2 Cor. 2:14

Resisting fear by choosing to build an atmosphere of peace will lead you to Joy.

"(...) those who plan peace have joy." Prov. 12:20 (English Standard Version)

JOY... A proof you are in the Spirit

"He who sits in the heaven shall laugh." Ps. 2:4

"A merry heart does good as medicine" Prov. 17:22 – It will activate God's power in you.

Neh. 8:10-11 - The joy of the Lord is our strength.
